NOTICE OF LEGAL PENALTIES AND LIABILITIES

When accepting a child for enrollment, the District may inform the parent or other person enrolling the child that presenting false information or false records for identification is a criminal offense under Penal Code 37.10 and that enrolling the child under false documents makes the person liable for tuition or other costs as provided below. Education Code 25.001(i)

A person who knowingly falsifies information on a form required for a student's enrollment in the District is liable to the District if the student is not eligible for enrollment, but is enrolled on the basis of false information. For the period during which the ineligible student is enrolled, the person is liable for the maximum tuition fee the District may charge [see FDB (LEGAL)] or the amount the District has budgeted per student as maintenance and operating expense, whichever is greater. Education Code 25.001(h)

Texas Transportation Code Section 521.054(b) provides that a person changing his or her address is required to notify the Texas Department of Public Safety of the change not later than the 30th day after the date on which the change takes effect and apply for a duplicate license or certificate as required by Section 521.146 of the Code. ***The parent or guardian needs to provide an updated driver's license to show the address on cohabitation agreement to the campus within 30 days from the date on this cohabitation agreement.***

Documents required for approval are listed on back

The following documentation is required for approval:

- Current Utility Bill (must be electric or water bill)
- Drivers license of district resident (name and address matching utility bill)
- Drivers license of parent (provide updated drivers license to campus within 30 days from date on cohabitation affidavit)
- Student(s) birth certificate

Only if the documentation is questionable will the families need to be sent to the Director of Student and Staff Services for final approval.
