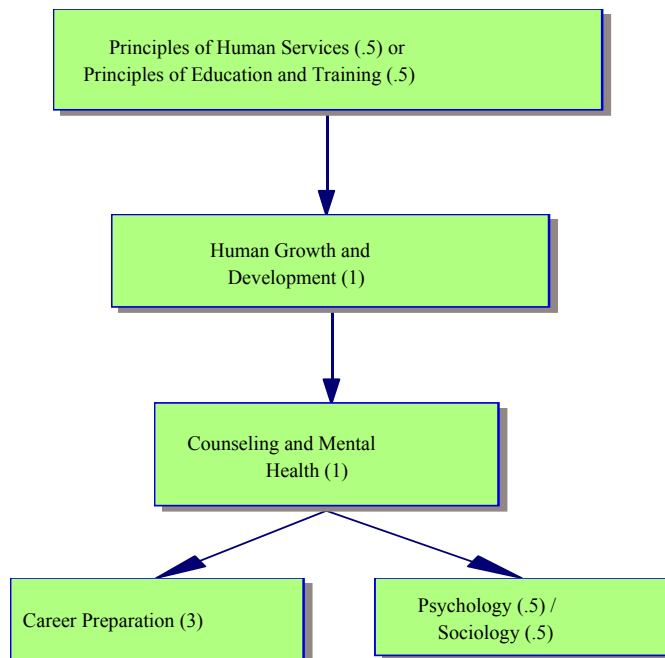

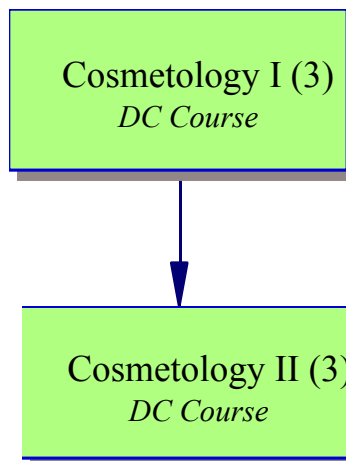


## Cosmetology

Cosmetology students participate in real-world, job-specific training for hair, nails, and skin care. The students who follow this pathway may participate in Skills USA competitions. Upon completion of the Cosmetology program students will take the exam for their Texas Cosmetology Operator License.

### Counseling and Mental Health

**PEIMS:** 13024600

**Grade Placement:** 10-12

**Prerequisite:** Principles of Education and Training *or*  
Principles of Human Services *or*  
Personal Family Development

**Credit:** 1

Students model the knowledge and skills necessary to pursue a counseling and mental health career through simulated environments. Students are expected to apply knowledge of ethical and legal responsibilities, limitations, and the implication of their actions.

### Principles of Human Services

**PEIMS:** 13024200

**Grade Placement:** 9-12

**Prerequisite:** None

**Credit:** .5

This course will enable students to investigate careers in the human services career cluster, including counseling and mental health, early childhood development, family and community, and personal care services.

### Cosmetology I

**PEIMS:** 13025200

**Grade Placement:** 11

**Prerequisite:** Specific Admission Requirements-Teacher  
Approval *and* Completion of Application  
Process, own transportation

### Cosmetology II

**PEIMS:** 13025300

**Grade Placement:** 12

**Prerequisite:** Cosmetology I, own transportation

**Credit:** 3

This two-year program provides students with job specific training for entry-level employment in cosmetology careers. It includes sterilization and sanitation processes, shampooing and rinsing hair, application of conditioning creams and color rinses, application of scalp and hair treatments, shaping and thinning hair, hairstyling, permanent waving, hair coloring, manicuring, facial massage, facial makeup, entrepreneurship, safety, leadership and career opportunities. In the second year this program continues with information and skills necessary to prepare for the Texas State Licensing Board of Cosmetology exam.
