Eagle Mountain Elementary Holiday Shop **Tuesday, December 10 – Friday, December 13**

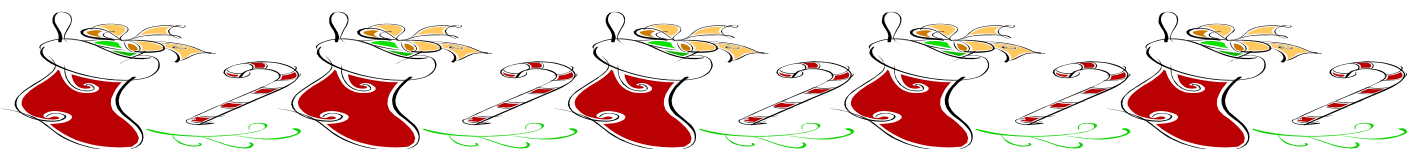
At the **EME Holiday Shop**, students will be shopping independently for family and friends.
