EIC (LOCAL) ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION

SEMESTER EXAMS

Semester exams account for 1/7 of the semester grade for a course.

EXEMPTIONS— SPRING ONLY A student may be exempted from taking a SPRING SEMESTER final examination in a course if s/he meets all the following criteria. The student has:

- 1. not been suspended (ISS, OSS, or DAEP) during the spring semester
- 2. a 90% or higher average in the course and no more than three absences
- 3. an 80% or higher average in the course and no more than two absences

A student is not counted absent when participating in extra-curricular activities or during a documented health care appointment.

COLLEGE VISITS

Junior and Senior students are allowed two college visit days per school year. College visit days will not count against juniors or seniors for the purpose of qualifying for exam exemptions.

AP EXAMINATIONS

A student who takes an Advanced Placement Exam for a course they are enrolled in during the Spring Semester is exempt from the semester exam in that course, providing the student has an average of 75 or higher, has no more than 3 absences during the 2nd semester and has met #1 above.
