CONCERT BAND AUDITIONS

- ➤ Wind Ensemble Top Band, almost all students here are taking private lessons
- ➤ **Symphonic Band** Second Band, Students encouraged to take lessons
- ➤ **Concert Band** Third Band, Students encouraged to take lessons
 - **Concert Winds** Fourth Band, Students encouraged to take lessons
 - Wind Ensemble, Symphonic, and Concert Band are UIL competing ensembles. All bands perform at Winter and Spring Concerts. Eligibility, attendance, concert attire, and dedication are consistent at every level.

ARENA SCHEDULING

What is Arena Scheduling?

Arena Scheduling is the process by which your child will select his/her course schedule for the 2021-2022 school year, down to the class period they are taking each course.

When do Students Select their Schedule? - I don't have an answer to this right now; I talked to the Counseling office today, and they haven't released that date.

When you do your Arena Scheduling, don't worry if the band class you see is not yet accurate. Do the best you can with the rest of your schedule, and we will be working with the counselors to make sure you are placed in the correct band class.

REGISTRATION & FEES

- Band Registration will be partially online for the 2021-2022 school year.
- > There are two parts to your online registration.
 - > First will be the online form set up by the Band Boosters organization. This is where you give us your contact information, and begin the process of ordering merchandise and paying band fees.
 - > Second will be your RankOne registration. This includes required permission slips through the district, such as the Band Contract, UIL 8-Hour Rule Acknowledgement, Drug Testing Consent Form, etc. This is also where you will get the required Medical History Form and Pre-Participation Physical form that we will talk about later.
- The Band Booster Registration Form is online NOW: https://bit.ly/3say7WX. We will put out the link through Twitter, Facebook, Remind and email. *Please complete your ONLINE registration as soon as possible, and by May 21st at the latest.*
- We will send instructions for RankOne signup through Twitter, Facebook, Remind, and email once we have been notified that it is available. The forms on the RankOne site (including Medical History Form and Physical exam form) must be filled out before a student can participate in 2020 marching band activities.



REGISTRATION & FEES

- > In-Person Band Registration will take place on Friday, May 21st and Saturday, May 22nd
- > Friday, May 21st (6-9pm) Returning Members
- > Saturday, May 22nd (9am-3pm) New Members



PHYSICALS FOR BAND MEMBERS

- ALL students participating in marching band are now required to obtain a
 physical exam, just like the physical exams that have been required of our
 student-athletes for years.
- If your student is in band AND athletics, they only have to get a physical ONCE, but will need to make a copy of the form and submit to both band directors AND athletic trainers.
- As we mentioned earlier, the required Medical History Form and the Pre-Participation Physical Form will be available through the RankOne website, and we will let you know when those forms are ready.

CTHS BAND FEES

INCLUDES: Meals, Show Shirt, Luggage Tag, Instruction, Transportation, Entry Fees, Show Design, 10 Ranger Regiment Discount Cards

Band Fees per student - \$525

New Student Purchases - \$210

Total = \$735

Payment Plans starting at Registration through November available. (6 Months)

A \$150 minimum deposit is due when you register (by May 22nd)

A \$25 discount will be credited to any account paid in full by May 22nd

A \$25 per child discount will credited to any family with multiple band students



WHAT DOES A YEAR OF BAND COST?

- > FOOD \$44,000
 - Students will be fed at summer band days, football games, and marching contests.
- **➤ CONTEST FEES \$3,000**
- ➤ EQUIPMENT TRUCK RENTAL & TRAILER UPDATES \$8,000
- ➤ COLOR GUARD SPECIALIST SALARY \$15,000
- ➤ COLOR GUARD TECH \$4,000



WHAT DOES A YEAR OF BAND COST?

- > SUMMER BAND SECTIONAL INSTRUCTION \$2400
- MARCHING BAND TECH PAYMENTS (Summer & Fall) \$12,000
- > MARCHING BAND SHOW DESIGN (Concept, Music, Drill) \$20,000
- **➤ MARCHING BAND VISUAL ELEMENTS \$15,000**



WHAT DOES A YEAR OF BAND COST?

- SHOW SHIRT- \$2200
- ➤ LUGGAGE TAGS \$600
- > PRIVATE LESSON SCHOLARSHIPS \$5000
- STUDENT LEADERSHIP CAMP \$3000

THAT'S A TOTAL OF \$134,200

WITH 180 STUDENTS IN THE PROGRAM, WITHOUT ANY FUNDRAISING, THAT WOULD BE ABOUT \$745 PER STUDENT, PLUS INDIVIDUAL ITEMS THAT ALL NEW MEMBERS NEED.

TO KEEP FEES AS LOW AS POSSIBLE, OUR GOAL IS TO FUNDRAISE \$50,000 THIS YEAR

VARSITY/Shadows

- EVERYONE IS A PARTICIPATING MEMBER OF THE CTHS RANGER REGIMENT!!!
- > <u>ALL</u> learn basic marching and drill fundamentals.
- ➤ <u>ALL</u> participate in the stands at <u>ALL</u> football games and pep rallies.
- ➤ <u>VARSITY</u> group competes at marching contests and performs at ALL halftime performances for football games.
- Varsity spots are limited and open to audition ONLY during the first few days of summer band.
 - > **Shadows** may participate in **some** halftime performances, and **some** members may be utilized for props, equipment help, or any other position within the varsity group deemed necessary for that season. Participation and attendance will factor into selecting individuals to participate with the varsity group.
- ➤ <u>Shadows</u> MAY be assigned a separate rehearsal schedule based on the responsibilities they are assigned.
- > Eligibility, attendance, preparation, etc... can also affect Varsity status.



FOOTBALL GAMES

- Held every Thursday, Friday, or Saturday every week during September, October, and the first two weeks in November (our last game is typically the first weekend in November).
- > **<u>REQUIRED</u>** attendance by ALL CTHS Band Members.
- Our primary focus is to provide support for our team, and entertainment for our fans.
- ➤ We will be involved during all four quarters of the game, and we will either march at Halftime or Postgame.
- All students are dismissed together from the band hall after EVERYTHING is unloaded, put away and accounted for. (Sometimes this takes a little while.)



MARCHING CONTESTS

- Late September through early November is Marching Contest Season!
 - Attendance **REQUIRED** for all CTHS Band Members
- > Parents are encouraged to attend all contest performances, and to cheer on **ALL** bands
- > The following is our schedule of marching contests for this year:
 - September 25th USBands Regional (Saginaw HS)
 - October 2nd NO CONTEST (Football Bye Week & SAT Test Date)
 - October 9th USBands Regional (Burleson HS)
 - October 12th UIL Region 30 Marching Contest (Saginaw HS)
 - October 16th Birdville Marching Festival (Birdville HS)
 - October 23rd UIL Area Marching Contest (TBA)



ELIGIBILITY

- No Pass, No Play applies to any *competitive* activity ALL year. This includes Marching Band, All-Region auditions, Solo & Ensemble Contest, Winter Guard, etc.
- ➤ It does NOT apply to our concerts that we hold here on our campus (Christmas concert, Spring concert, etc.), nor does it apply to UIL Region Concert & Sightreading (this is seen as an assessment, not a competition).
- \triangleright **EVERYONE** who passed the previous grade is eligible until end of 1st 6 Weeks.
- Students must pass <u>ALL CLASSES</u> the <u>FIRST</u> 6 weeks in order to participate with the marching band at contests in October.



ATTENDANCE

- Good attendance is necessary for the band to be successful.
- > Rehearsals start at indicated time; students must be <u>**READY TO PLAY**</u> at that time.
- Absences need to be communicated to the band director 24 hours in advance when possible. Please call or email.
- Examples of an excused absence: illness, injury, doctors' appointment (with a note), death in the family, etc...
- Examples of unexcused absences: birthday, shopping, hair appointment, drivers license testing, etc...
- Please plan ahead for any appointments, extensive dental work, SAT, ACT, etc...
 - If you're taking the ACT, avoid the October 23rd test date this year



EQUIPMENT

WOODWINDS and BRASS

- For most instruments, it is best to have 2 instruments: one for marching, one for concert, if possible.
- School-owned instruments will be issued one for each season.
- Detailed equipment recommendations are found in the CTHS Band Handbook (available on the CTHS Band website)
