3 specialty campuses: Hafley Development Center, Watson High School/Alternative Discipline Center, Hollenstein Career and Technology Center




- 7<sup>th</sup>-fastest growing district in DFW

# **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL #16**



- Elementary school site in Copper Creek
- Closed on the property on February 13, 2018
- Planned to open in August 2020



- 68% of voters in favor of the proposition.
- Tax rate remains at \$1.54, the same since 2012-13.

Prepare for Growth	Prepare for District growth by building high school #4, purchasing land, and providing contingency funding for Natatorium.
Upgrade Safety & Security	Upgrade security systems by adding new cameras, creating controlled vestibules with access control, adding fences, sidewalks, and making updates to playgrounds.
Aging & Inadequate Systems & Facilities	Replace Wayside Middle School, centralize administrative offices, renovate ag barn, update athletic facilities, roofs, flooring, sound systems, lights, etc.
Standardization & Equity	Update campuses to ensure equity among schools and programs while bringing systems to District standard.
<b>Contingency Funds</b>	Allow for unforeseen conditions, circumstances, or expenses.
