Badger Parents,

Let us be the first to welcome you and your child to our athletic program! We are excited and looking forward to working with the next generation of Badger Athletes. As we start preparing for next year, we wanted to share some important information with you about our athletics' program.

Physical

The 2020-21 school year brings lots of new challenges and a break from the "normal" way we prepare for athletics. The biggest change is that the UIL has suspended new physicals for some of the athletes for one year. The following athletes will need **NEW physicals**:

- Incoming 7th graders
- Students who did NOT participate in athletics for the 2019-20 school year
- Athletes with medical conditions which they are under a doctor's care (These will be identified through the digital medical history by the high school athletic training staff and a parent will be notified)

Rank One Online Paperwork

Parents, the Rank One Online Paperwork is very important. This paperwork needs to be completed online in order for your child to participate in any athletic sports program. There are three documents that need to be completed are the **Medical History Form**, **Sports Participation Packet** and the **Emergency Card**. Please see attachment of Rank One Instructions. It is recommended to complete the Rank One Online Paperwork by the parent meeting date.

Athletic Uniforms

Your child must purchase an athletic uniform. The athletic uniform consists of 1 shirt and 1 short. The cost for the athletic uniform is **\$30.00**. It is recommended to purchase two sets of athletic uniforms. Athletic uniforms will be sold at the parent meeting and throughout the school year at the school. Purchase can be made with cash or check. If purchasing with a check, please make the check out to Ed Willkie Middle School. Please provide student's name in memo section as well as date of birth and driver's license number.

Equipment Fees & Game Day Dress Code (Agreement) - See attachment.

EMS and EWMS Athletic Handbooks (Agreement) – The EMS ISD athletic handbook is online and the EWMS handbook will be available at our parent meeting. Agreement Forms for both will also be available at our meeting.

Sports

At Ed Willkie Middle School, we offer the following sports:

Football	Cross Country	Tennis
Volleyball	Track	Golf
Basketball	Soccer	Gymnastics

We recommend that your child participates in as many sports as possible.

All sports have a try-out procedure (except for football). That means that your child must try-out to make a team in that sport. As stated before, the exception is football. There are no cuts in football. Your child will be on a football team if he tries out for the football team.

If your child participates in football, volleyball, or basketball, then he/she needs to be enrolled in the athletic class.

Cross Country and Track

Cross-country and track are sports that are either before school or after school. Your child does not have to be in the athletic class to participate in these two sports, but we do highly recommend that your child be in the athletic class to improve their chances to make the team and to try-out for other sports while in athletics.

Soccer and Tennis

Soccer and tennis have their own athletic period. If your child is solely going to play either soccer or tennis, then they should be in one of these classes. However, if your child is planning to try out for other sports like football, volleyball, basketball, then we highly recommend that your child be enrolled in the athletic class.

Golf and Gymnastics

Golf and gymnastics are unique sports for your child to try-out and participate. Both sports are done at Chisholm Trail High School. High school coaches will coach your child at the high school. You must take your child to CTHS and a bus will bring them back to Ed Willkie. If you have a child participating in golf, they must have your own set of golf clubs. In addition, your child will not be able to participate in our athletic class if he/she is in golf or gymnastics.

We hope this information is beneficial and will help you and your child make an informed decision on whether to participate in our athletic program.

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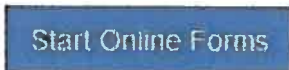

These forms must be completed prior to athletic participation

To complete the required medical forms, please follow these instructions:

1. Go to <https://eaglemountainisd.rankonesport.com/New/Home.aspx>
2. Click on the tab that says "Electronic Participation Forms"
3. Scroll to the bottom of the page, where you should see this:



4. Once you click on this button, you will be redirected to a page, which asks, "Have you previously created a Parent Account when completing forms online?" followed by several options. Search the option that fits you best and go from there!
5. Please make sure that you complete **Medical History Form**, **Sports Participation Packet** and the **Emergency Card**. You will be able to see Approved/Incomplete out to the side, so there should be no need to call and check on form status

If you are required to get a sports physical or further medical clearance, we suggest you get this scheduled ASAP, as medical resources are stretched thin. Waiting until the beginning of sports will result in many people having to sit out until their clearance is completed. Remember that all physicals must be completed on the UIL approved physical form.

Once you have the physical form completed by a doctor, it must be turned into your Middle School Coordinator. DO NOT turn this form into the school front office or a coach.

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Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

Practice uniforms are required for all athletes in Athletics. Each student must purchase at least one set of athletic shorts and shirt for practice, as we promote unity and cohesiveness. Other athletic equipment or supplies that maybe required for purchase would be athletic shoes, sweats, spirit wear, etc. It is recommended that the boys' athletes purchase an athletic supporter.

All athletes are responsible for taking care of and keeping up with all equipment issued to them. All athletes will be required to return all athletic equipment in good condition at the end of the sport season. Any equipment not returned or damaged at the end of the sport season, will result in payment for the replacement of the lost or damaged item(s). All athletes are required to be cleared by their head coaches of any equipment, uniforms, etc. before entering another sport. If any equipment is not returned or paid for, the athlete is subject to not participating in the next sport and may receive a hold on school equipment/reports.

At no time, may ANY school issued equipment checked out to your child, be shared with or lent to any one for any reason. Consequences for not following this directive will be given.

We also want our athletes to demonstrate team and school pride during our football, volleyball and basketball seasons. If your son or daughter makes a team, all team members will be required to dress up on game day. Our young men wear a shirt and tie. The shirt must be a business collared shirt and the tie can be any color. Our young ladies wear a nice shirt or sweater, dress pants, dresses or skirts with no tennis shoes. Everyone must follow our district's school dress code. If there are any concerns about the shirt and ties, please contact the coaching staff.

Middle School Athletics

Students in “Good Standing”

Students participating in any athletic program will be monitored for academics, behavior, and attendance. Any negative drops in behavior, academics, or attendance during the year may result in disciplinary athletic consequences and/or possible removal from the program. We expect this contract to help student/athletes move forward positively, academically, behaviorally, and athletically.

The Four Components of Good Standing

Academics

Attendance

Behavior

Sportsmanship

1.) Academics

Being a Student/Athlete will always be the primary focus.

- Completing homework is non-negotiable. All homework is to be completed. Multiple incomplete grades or “zeroes” can result in a student being **not in good standing**.
- Interim reports and other progress reports may be obtained from teachers.
- Unsatisfactory academic progress may cause a student to be **not in good standing**.

2.) Attendance

“When you miss school, you miss out!”

- You must be present in school the day of practice, meets, and games in order to participate.
- Being sent to ISS for being tardy can result in a student being **not in good standing**.
- Multiple unexcused absences can result in a student being **not in good standing**.

3.) Behavior

Exemplary behavior is expected from all students that represent our school both on and off the court or athletic field.

- ISS and OSS for referrals written will result in the player being **not in good standing** for the duration of the ISS or OSS assignment. This goes for bus referrals as well. Students will not participate in practice, games, or meets when **not in good standing**.
- Teams stay together while at games or meets. There is to be no traveling around a home team’s school while waiting for the start of a game. Stay together as a team during away games.
- Conduct detrimental to the team culture or program, including but not limited to violations to the student code of conduct including social media will result in the student being **not in good standing**.

4.) Sportsmanship

All Athletes will exhibit appropriate sportsmanship in all games and practices. Poor sportsmanship includes the following:

- Arguing with coaches, referees, or officials
- Being ejected from a game or meet
- Receiving technical fouls for behavior on the court/during a game
- Taunting, belittling, “showboating” or “trash-talking” opposing players
- Communicating with spectators
- Any conduct that is detrimental to the team or to Middle School.

Students who are in violation of good sportsmanship will be **not in good standing** for the following week.
