 - 2022 Federal Income Tax Return
 - Student Social Security Number
- How do I get a FSA ID Number?

- When can I start?
 - *FSA ID Now!!!*
 - *FAFSA December 1, 2024 (Tentative)*
- When/How can I get help?
 - FAFSA Nights –January & February (Dates TBD)
- New State Requirement: All Student Must
 - Complete the FAFSA or
 - Complete the TASFA or
 - Submit Opt-Out Agreement

- Dec. 1: Regular Application Deadline

- Nov 1: Early Action/Early Decision (Binding) Deadline
- Feb. 1: Regular Application Deadline

University of Texas at Arlington

- Feb. 15: Priority Application Deadline
- No Regular Application Deadline Posted

 - Only Colleges/Universities in Texas
- Common App
 - www.commonapp.org
 - Some Texas Private Schools & Out of State Schools
- Specific College/University Website
 - Compare all schools for common submission preference
 - Some schools will be through the website

Other College Deadlines

Financial Aid Deadlines

- FAFSA Typically Required
- Some Are First Come First Served

Housing Deadline

- First Come First Served
- Typically not Available Until Admission Application is Complete

Scholarship Deadlines

- May be earlier than Admission Deadlines
- May vary by type of scholarship

- State Placement Exam
- Student may be exempt (SAT/ACT, Texas College Bridge Completion)
