RECOMMENDED COURSE SEQUENCE

Principles of Audio/Video Production (1 credit) (9th - 10th Grade)

Obtain the introductory skills of audio/video production through team and individual projects. Improve your knowledge and skills in communication, interpersonal interactions, and professional presentation.



Digital Audio Tech 1 & 2 (HCTC) (2 credits) (11th Grade)

Collaborate with your peers to produce radio, TV, and film broadcasts with a focus on audio production. Explore a variety of team member roles through project-based learning.

Develop interpersonal skills needed for a successful career in broadcasting through real-world interactions with clients seeking audio productions. Enhance leadership skills through a variety of project-based experiences designed to familiarize students with the multiple roles of a broadcast team.

Practicum in Audio Production* (HCTC) (2 credits) (12th Grade)

Focus on enhancing advanced skills and techniques used in audio mixing and editing. Students develop problem solving and project management strategies by navigating through production scenarios common in music and sound for media production.
