EMS ISD Student Scholarship Application Instructions: (Read carefully, complete *full* application)

This scholarship application automatically considers you for local scholarships. These include the EMS ISD Education Foundation merit scholar, PTO and PTA scholarships, local business scholarships, Memorial scholarships and more! You need to complete this single application to be eligible for dozens of local scholarships, which generally range from \$500 to \$3,000 each. The criteria for selecting winners vary from scholarship to scholarship. For example, some scholarships are awarded based upon grades and test scores, while others are considered for extra-curricular activities, community citizenship and future goals, so please answer each question with as much detail as possible. These scholarships may also be awarded to students interested in a particular field of study (i.e. education, athletics, engineering, etc.), so it is important that you complete the entire application, along with submitting two teacher recommendation forms. Forms must go to teachers 2 weeks before the deadline to submit this application in order to give them sufficient time to complete and return to your counselor.

***Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Guidelines and Useful Suggestions:

1. The student application is due to your Counselor's office no later than **February 22, 2019**
2. The two teacher recommendation forms must be submitted to the Counselor's office no later than **February 22, 2019**. The recommendations go directly to the counselor, they do not come back to the student.
3. **THE APPLICATION MUST BE TYPED IF NOT COMPLETED THROUGH ONLINE FORM.** Hand-written applications will not be accepted. The EMS ISD scholarship application is available to download from the websites: www.emsef.org or can also be found on the home campus counseling site under the scholarship link.
4. All questions must be answered. Only these forms can be used to record information for this scholarship. Please use only the space provided on the application to respond to each question. Do not attach resumes or any extra sheets with additional information to this scholarship application, as attachments are NOT allowed.
5. Do not include your name or the name of any family member in any of the questions. The only place your name should be is on the **Cover Page** and the **last sheet** of this application packet where your signature is required. If you are under 18, your parent must also sign this application.

Useful tips: Spell and punctuate correctly. Have someone else check your work for mistakes. *If you do not have access to a typewriter or computer to type this application, please speak with your Guidance Counselor for assistance.*
