Test Structure: English, Math, Reading, Science	Test Structure : Reading, Math, Writing and Language
Length: 2 hours and 55 minutes	Length: 3 hours
Reading (40 questions @ 35 minutes): 4 reading passages	Reading (52 questions @ 65 min): Reading passages or pairs of passages
English (75 questions @ 45 minutes): Grammar, punctuation, sentence structure, and rhetorical skills	Writing & Language (44 questions @ 35 minutes): Grammar vocabulary in context, and editing skills
Math (60 questions @ 60 minutes): Arithmetic, Algebra I and II (accounts for 33 questions), Geometry accounts for 23 questions), Trigonometry, and Probability and Statistics	Math - No Calculator (20 questions @ 25 minutes): Math - With Calculator (38 questions @ 55 minutes): Arithmetic, Algebra I and II (accounts for half of test questions), Geometry, Trigonometry and Data Analysis
Science (40 questions @ 35 minutes): 1 section testing critical thinking- not factual knowledge	Science: none
Calculator Policy: You can use a calculator on all math questions.	Calculator Policy: Some math questions do not allow use of a calculator. (38 with, 20 without)
Scoring: Scored on a scale from 1 to 36- Composite score is the average of the 4 section scores -no penalization for incorrect answers	Scoring: Scored on a scale of 400-1600- no penalization for incorrect answers

Suggested Time per Question:

*On average, students should spend 50-60 seconds per question.
Each section is timed differently.

Suggested Time per Question:

*On average, students should spend 75-85 seconds per questions.
Each section is timed differently.
