UPDATE ON EMS ISD STUDENT MEALS:

Beginning Thursday, March 19, EMS ISD will bundle lunch and breakfast together for pick up between 11 am-1 pm on weekdays so that students get lunch for the current day and will already have their breakfast for the next morning. This will allow for more social distancing and fewer instances of interactions in support of public health and CDC guidelines. Thursday, March 19, will be the last morning that breakfast can be picked up between 8-9 am. There will be no 8-9 am breakfast pickups starting Friday, March 20. Curbside meals are being provided to any person age 18 or younger at the following locations: Northbrook ES, Gilliland ES, Saginaw ES, Dozier ES, and Highland MS. Due to federal program requirements, children must be present to receive meals. All meals will be served by certified child nutrition workers for EMS ISD as required by the health department.
