Prepare for your future in protective services through hands on coursework in emergency services, law enforcement, and forensic science.

RECOMMENDED COURSE SEQUENCE

- 1** Principles of Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security (1 credit) (9th - 10th Grade)
Examine the roles and responsibilities of professionals in law enforcement, security, corrections and fire and emergency services. Explore the interconnectivity of local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies.
- 2** Firefighter 1 Dual Credit (TCC Northwest) (2 credits) (11th Grade)
Analyze Texas Commission on Fire Protection rules and regulation, proper incident reporting and records, proper use of personal protections equipment and the principles of fire safety.
- 3** Firefighter 2 Dual Credit (TCC Northwest) (2 credits) (12th Grade)
Continue the study of fire fighter safety and development. Learn the proper procedures for the use of fire extinguishers, ladders, firehose, and water supply apparatus. Completion of this course gives students priority status for admission to the Fire Academy at TCC.
