The AP Environmental Science course is interdisciplinary and will integrate the sciences including biology, chemistry, and earth science with the social sciences to analyze and predict contemporary environmental issues. The course will provide students with scientific principles, concepts, and methodologies required to understand the interrelationships of the natural world, to identify and analyze environmental problems both natural and human made, to evaluate the relative risks associated with these problems, and to examine alternative solutions for resolving and/or preventing them.
