

8th Grade On-Level Science Parent Guide

This course is designed to provide students with the skills necessary to apply science concepts to their everyday life. Along with being able to ask questions and solve problems, students will be able to collect and organize data, and draw conclusions based on their findings. While much of the focus is on earth and space science, the course is built on the following strands: scientific investigations and reasoning; matter and energy; force, motion, and energy; earth and space; and organisms and environment. In advanced science, students will engage in inquiry-based science including designing and conducting their own investigations, learning to use and develop critical thinking skills, and using problem-solving methods.
