

Elementary Interim Grading Regulations 2019-2020

COVID-19 has caused a major shift in daily practices for everyone, including public education. Following Eagle Mountain-Saginaw ISD's mission of providing a culture of excellence for every student, we have transitioned to a distance learning model that ensures our students' education follows our curriculum and provides opportunities to continue their learning. This grading model is designed to provide for the accountability of a student's learning while remaining flexible and supportive of the home learning environment. The EMS ISD Interim Grading Regulations will be followed for the 2019-2020 spring semester.



Passing Requirements and Grade Promotion

- Students will have the ability to redo assignments multiple times until he/she has mastered the curricular concept (70% or higher).
- If a student is unable to show mastery (70% or higher) of the standards in a course, he/she may be required to attend summer school or another intervention upon the recommendation of the Grade Placement Committee.



Report Cards

- Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and First Grade will continue to receive standards-based progress reports.
- Report Cards for elementary will be posted at the end of the 4th nine weeks.
