Read, make, and write high frequency words:

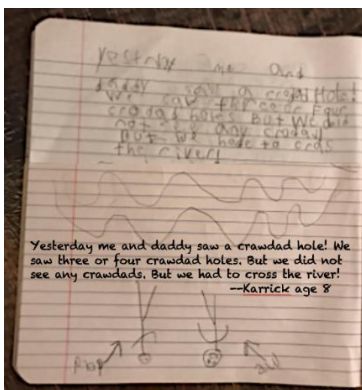
