Read/Listen the stories and follow up with questions about the story. Ask about the who was in the story, where the story happened, how can the story end differently and what connections your child has to the story.

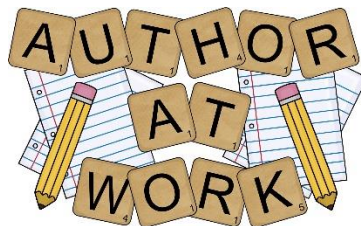

Choice 2: Be an Author!

Children love to create stories. Allow your child to write about different topics. You can select a special occasion, specific event or anything that has meaning to your child. You can use any paper, folded in half to create a book. Encourage your child to think of themselves as an "author" (like in the books they read). Some students write stories using letters and some use pictures. Both types of writing are appropriate for children this age.
