# Opportunities for Advancement

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- College-level courses offered in the high school setting
- AP Exam opportunity at the end of the course
  - Colleges may award credit for students earning qualifying scores on AP Exams
  - AP Exam fee required
- Open enrollment for all students



# AP Exam – Yes? Or No?

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- It depends. Questions to ask yourself:
  - Do I score well on standardized tests?
  - Do I have a history of standardized test or AP Exam scores to look at?
  - How comfortable am I with the information or subject?
  - Will the college I am considering accept the exam as a credit for a course I need?



# 2021-2022 AP Exam Information

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## Two step process

1. Register for exam at [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org)
2. Pay for exam(s) using the Total Registration Portal

**2021 AP Regular Exam Cost:** \$91 per exam

*\*Fee reductions are available for qualifying students*

**2021 AP Capstone/Research Exam Cost:** \$139

*\*Fee reductions are available for qualifying students*

**Exam Decision and Required Deposit Deadline:** \$44 per exam by October 22, 2021

*\*After the exam order is placed, no refunds can be given for deposits.*

**Final Payment Deadline:** February 4, 2022

*\*Students must pay in full for all exams by this deadline. Exams not paid in full will be canceled. No refunds will be given for any deposit due to College Board cancellation fees.*



## Late Fees/Cancellation Fees

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- If a student orders an exam after the October deadline, a \$40 late fee will be assessed by College Board.
  - This payment must be made by the student in Total Registration.
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- If a student chooses to cancel an exam after the October deadline, a \$40 cancellation fee will be assessed by College Board.
  - If a student does not show to take the AP Exam in May, a \$40 cancellation fee will be assessed by College Board.
  - This payment must be made by the student in Total Registration.

## October 22

- Deposits due (or payment made in full)

## February 4

- Final payment deadline
