

Seniors, are you interested in pursuing a degree or certificate at TCC after high school graduation? Are you planning to take a summer class at TCC that will transfer to a four-year college?

Follow the steps below become a TCC student.

Step 1: Online Interest Card

Step 2: TCC Application

- Complete the application to Tarrant County College using the [Apply TCC](#) application.

- [Complete the application to TCC by January 13, 2021, to be eligible to participate in TSI testing on the CTHS campus.](#) Testing dates are to be determined.

Step 3: WebAdvisor & TCC Email Setup

- After completing the application to TCC, you should receive an email within 48 to 72 hours from TCC that includes your TCC ID number, email address, and instructions for accessing WebAdvisor. Once you have that email, follow the steps below.

Step 4: Pre-Assessment Activity & TSI Assessment

- The TSI is an exam that determines college readiness in the areas of writing, reading, and math. This exam is the entrance exam for TCC and determines if you are eligible to enroll in college level coursework. The TSI may also be required by four-year colleges in Texas for college course enrollment, if you do not meet the TSI exemption criteria.
