

**Submit Meningitis Vaccination Record & Minor Consent Form to TCC.**

*(Only required prior to enrollment for courses taken in-person on a TCC campus.)*

**Meningitis Vaccination Record**

1. Records can be uploaded via your WebAdvisor account. Log in, click the STUDENT MENU, and search for meningitis vaccination.
2. Records can be submitted to the TCC NW Campus Registrar's Office in-person.

You will not be able to register for a course held on a TCC campus until your vaccination record is submitted.

**Minor Consent Form**

1. Login to your TCC WebAdvisor Account. From the STUDENT MENU, click the Health Services or Minor Consent Form Link and complete the form online.

**Texas Success Initiative (TSIA2) Assessment**

To be eligible to participate in dual credit, students are required to meet the admissions criteria of Tarrant County College (TCC), which includes completion of the TSIA2 assessment (reading, writing, & math). Below you will find information pertaining to this assessment and how this assessment is used by TCC.

The **Texas Success Initiative Assessment** (TSIA or TSIA2) is the state-mandated placement test (Texas Education Code §51.333) that Texas public institutions of higher education must use to determine a student's readiness for college-level courses.

*Example Scenario*

- o A student receives a *CRC score of 945 or higher with an Essay score of 5 or higher* on the ELAR section of the TSIA2. The student can then enroll in a college level course for college credit, for example, US History (HIST 1301).
- or-**
- o A student does not receive the minimum score ELAR section of the TSIA 2. The student will not be able to enroll in US History (HIST 1301).

**TSIA2 Required Scores**

<b>ELAR</b> (Reading & Writing)	CRC 945-990 AND Essay 5-8 <b>-OR-</b> CRC 910-944 AND Diagnostic Level 5-6 AND Essay 5-8
<b>Math</b>	CRC 950-990 <b>-OR-</b> CRC 910-949 AND Diagnostic Level 6

**TSIA2 Exemptions**

Students meeting any of the following criteria can be exempt from the corresponding TSIA2 section.

<b>PSAT</b>	EBRW ( <i>Evidence Based Reading &amp; Writing</i> ) Section Score: <b>460</b> Math Section Score: <b>510</b>
<b>SAT</b>	EBRW ( <i>Evidence Based Reading &amp; Writing</i> ) Section Score: <b>480</b> Math Section Score: <b>530</b>
<b>ACT</b>	Composite Score: <b>23</b> , <b>-AND-</b> English Section Score: <b>19</b> Math Section Score: <b>19</b>

*\*For TCC to accept SAT or ACT scores as an exemption, students must send their scores to TCC through the College Board or ACT website. Scores must be sent as soon as possible to allow TCC to process the exemption.*

### TSIA2 Testing Locations

Students that complete all the dual credit enrollment steps via Canvas, by the posted deadline, will be scheduled to take the TSIA2 on their home campus.

For students that miss testing on the home campus, students must take the exam through TCC.

Testing options at TCC include taking the exam in person at the TCC NW Campus Testing Center, or online through a remote proctoring service called Examity.

Students must follow the procedures to schedule in-person or remote testing through TCC.

### Course Registration (For Qualifying Students)

Once students complete the TCC enrollment steps, and meet the required scores on the required assessment, students are eligible to enroll in courses.

Students must register for courses through their TCC WebAdvisor/MyTCCTrack account. Students must complete online registration by the deadline identified for each enrollment term. If students do not complete this process, they will not be registered for the course through TCC.

**NOTE:** Specific registration instructions and information will be sent to the student EMS ISD email accounts when registration is available. Students are expected to follow the instructions to self-register for the appropriate courses through TCC WebAdvisor.
