Students will wear masks/face coverings while they are actively playing/singing. Students in EMS-ISD athletics/PE will wear face masks unless actively exercising. This includes locker rooms, and when they are not able to 6 feet social distance. Students will always keep their masks with them. They remove them while actively exercising, but they must put them back on once their activity is over, or while transitioning through stations.
