Parent and Staff Feedback on Distance Learning and Planning for Next Year

Results and Analysis

Eagle Mountain Saginaw ISD June - July 2020





Project Overview

The Eagle Mountain Saginaw ISD (EMS) Feedback on Distance Learning and the Opening of Schools for 2020-2021 School Year Survey was distributed to district parents and district staff members.

The surveys were open from June 24 to July 7. Parents and staff members could take the survey using a public URL.

This report summarizes survey results. Results do not reflect random sampling; therefore, they should not be generalized to all EMS ISD parents and staff members. Rather, results reflect only the perceptions and opinions of survey participants.

Findings for each item in the report exclude participants who did not answer. Data labels less than 5 percent are not shown in charts and graphs. Percentages may not total 100 due to rounding.



Executive Summary

- Overall, 53% of participating parents said their child's experience with distance learning was successful or somewhat successful.

 Additionally, 53% of participating staff members said their experience with distance learning was successful or somewhat successful.
- Overall, 31% of participating parents said the biggest obstacle for their child with distance learning was lack of motivation/focus. While 22% of participating staff members said there was no obstacle for them with distance learning, 27% of staff selected 'other'. The main response associated with 'other' was lack of student participation and/or trouble contacting students.
- Three-quarters (75%) of participating parents said they had enough support from their child's teacher(s) and 81% said they had enough educational resources. Additionally, 94% of participating staff members said they had enough support from their instructional leaders and 86% said they had enough educational resources.
- 73% of participating parents strongly agreed or agreed that their child is prepared for the next grade level following EMS ISD distance learning.
- Overall, 83% of parents and 85% of staff members said the district's response and communication surrounding the COVID-19 crisis was
 excellent or good.
- Half of all participating parents, 50%, said they are planning to send their child(ren) back to EMS ISD for the fall semester and 37% are still deciding. Additionally, 69% of parents said they plan to return their child to EMS ISD, as normal with enhanced health and safety measures and 29% said they plan for their child(ren) to learn at home/online with EMS ISD.
- Overall, 64% of participating staff members are very concerned or concerned with returning to work under current circumstances.
- Overall, 89% of instructional staff are interested or somewhat interested in teaching in-person only for the fall semester, 62% are interested or somewhat interested in teaching in-person and online, and 70% are interested or somewhat interested in teaching online only.





Child's Experience with Distance Learning


Overall, how successful do you feel your child's experience was with distance learning? (N=2,865)





Frequency of Participation


How often did your child participate in distance learning? (N=2,866)

What do you feel was the biggest obstacle for your child with distance learning? (N=2,861)









Which of the following methods of communication worked for your child to reach his/her teacher(s)? (N=2,866)


Which of the following methods of communication worked for you, as the parent/guardian, to connect with your child's teacher(s)? (Check all that apply.) (N=2,867)


Which of the following communication methods do you prefer for receiving information from schools and/or the district? (N=2,870)


Regarding technology tools, which of the following devices did your child have regular access to for his/her schoolwork? (Check all that apply.) (N=2,871)




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statement? I feel like my child is prepared for the next grade level following EMS Distance Learning. (N=2,861)


Overall, how do you think the district has handled the response and communication regarding the COVID-19 situation and its impact on students, families, and our schools? (N=2,867)





Likelihood for Sending to In-Person Instruction








Which of the following options are you most likely to choose for your child for fall 2020? (N=2,828)






Semester Exams in Fall

How important do you think it is to administer semester exams at the end of the fall semester for courses that run the full length of the school year? (N=697)






Overall, how successful was your experience with distance learning? (N=709)





Frequency of Participation


How often did you participate in distance learning? (N=712)

What do you believe the biggest obstacle was for you with distance learning? (N=707)







Which methods of communication worked for you to reach your students? (N=711)


Which methods of communication worked for you to connect with your students' parents/guardians? (N=708)












Semester Exams in Fall


How important do you think it is to administer semester exams at the end of the fall semester for courses that run the full length of the school year? (N=220)
