Safety Procedures and Protocols

Bus Protocols

To be determined by Goldstar Transportation

Entering the Building

- 8:00 Enter the building and go to first period class
- Enter through the bus entrance teachers on duty will monitor mask use and provide hand sanitizer.
- Random temperature checks upon entry into the building
- Drop of band instrument in band room
- Go to cafeteria for grab-n-go breakfast
- All students report to their 1st period class
- Students may carry a string backpack containing lunch, water bottle, and/or PPE, their reading book, and their binder.
- Lockers before 1st period due to (7th grade athletics after first period).
 Phones will be placed in lockers and the big backpack will be placed in the locker.

In Class

- Hand sanitizer upon entry into the classroom
- Shield for every other desk
- Cleaning the Desk (Assign student to clean at the end of class; rotate students each day. Student will be provided appropriate PPE.)
- We will have shields on each alternating desk.
- Handwashing and personal hygiene lessons will be taught in science class.
- While in class, students will wear face coverings.
- While actively participating in PE/Athletics, students will remove face coverings, but return the covering once they return to a sedentary state.

We will follow our health and safety protocols, including self-screening prior to event, wearing of masks when not socially distanced, washing hands or using hand sanitizer, and socially distancing as feasible.

Passing Period

- Keep kids moving and stay on the right side of the hallway
- Restroom only
- Aides will monitor restrooms to prevent congregating and enforcing social distancing.
- All students will wear face mask, covering or gaiter.

Lunch

- Teacher walks to assigned table
- Eat while not talking
- Once a student has finished eating, mask will be returned to face and student may talk with other students
- Released one table at a time
- Pump of hand sanitizer
- No cash accepted

End of the Day

- Staggered release for bus riders/ walker/ riders (2 minutes)
- 8th graders to lockers after 7th period

Medical Protocol

- To Be Provided by District Nursing Department

Student will be taught our campus protocols during the first two days of face-to-face learning.

All students and staff members will be required to wear a face covering.

As much as possible and when space permits, we will practice social distancing.

Visitors will be minimized and will conduct all business in the main office. Visitors will be screened for COVID symptoms.
