### HEALTH CHECK

Please make sure your student is not feeling ill or exhibiting any symptoms. If they have symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19, please visit [www.emsisd.com](http://www.emsisd.com)

### GEAR

Don't forget your mask or face mask or gaiter. The school will supply a face covering if a student does not have one. Students may choose to wear a face shield in addition to a mask during times when working in close proximity without the ability to socially distance. Bring school supplies and will not share supplies. Also, bring your backpack, lunch or lunch money, refillable water bottle, and follow the student dress code.

### ARRIVAL

Campuses will share their drop-off individual locations with families. Students must wear face covering before entering the building. No parents/guardians will be allowed to exit their vehicles or walk into the building. Thank you for understanding this is for everyone's safety. Students will enter and be able to grab a breakfast and go directly to their class.

### DAILY ROUTINES

Where feasible, without disrupting the educational experience, students are encouraged to practice social distancing. Students are assigned a desk in the classroom and will sit in their assigned space while in the classroom. Teachers will have cleaning supplies for use in the classroom.

### NAVIGATING

While transitioning to common areas and to classrooms, all adults and students will wear face masks. Students will not be allowed to congregate during transitions and follow directions in place by the campus while maintaining social distancing.

### MEALS

When feasible, cafeteria seats will be placed 6 feet apart and, whenever possible, students will be asked to socially distance. Students will be required to wear a face mask unless they are eating or drinking.

### DISMISSAL

At dismissal of the school day, students will be encouraged to leave the building through the nearest exterior door to minimize congestion. In addition, parents and family member may not walk-up to the campus for student pick up at the campus.
