AP courses provide an opportunity to earn college credit upon passing the AP exams.

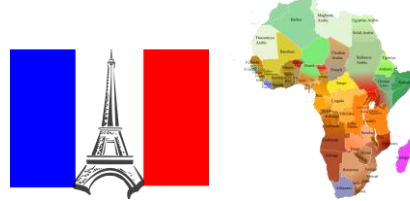
For students who plan education or careers outside of this country, AP courses provide an opportunity to build strong communication skills needed to adapt.
