

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Goal 1: STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT: We will provide quality Tier I instruction and systematic intervention to ensure high levels of learning for all students (ASPIRE 1, 2, 4, 5).

Performance Objective 1: By the end of the 2019 - 2020 school year, 88% of 3rd grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 60% of 3rd grade students will Meet Standard on the 2020 STAAR Math Assessment; 80% of 4th grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 50% of 4th grade students will Meet Standard on the 2020 STAAR Math Assessment; 95% of 5th grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 75% of 5th grade students will Meet Standard by the second administration of the the 2020 STAAR Math Assessment

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 2: By the end of the 2019 - 2020 school year, 85% of 3rd grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 60% of 3rd grade students will Meet Standard on the 2020 STAAR Reading Assessment; 90% of 4th grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 60% of 4th grade students will Meet Standard on the 2020 STAAR Reading Assessment; 94% of 5th grade students will meet the Approaching Standard and 75% of 5th grade students will Meet Standard by the second administration of the the 2020 STAAR Reading Assessment.

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 3: By the end of the 2019 - 2020 school year, 90% of students will meet or exceed Approaching Standard and 70% of students will meet or exceed Meeting Standard on the 2019 STAAR Science Assessment.

Performance Objective 4: By the end of the 2019 - 2020 school year, 70% of students will meet or exceed Approaching Standard and 40% of students will Meet Standard on the 2019 Writing Assessment.

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 5: By the end of the 2019- 2020 school year, 50% of special education students will meet or exceed the approaches standard category as measured by the 2019 STAAR assessment

Performance Objective 6: By the end of 2019 - 2020 school year, 85% of kindergarten, first, and second grade students will meet or exceed grade level expectations, as measured by the Fountas & Pinnell Assessment system.

Goal 2: COLLABORATIVE COMMUNITY: We will provide resources and opportunities enabling staff, students, parents, and community to work together to achieve desired results (ASPIRE 3, 4, 6)

Performance Objective 1: During the 2019 - 2020 school year, 100% of the professional staff will be provided professional learning that increases their capacity to provide rigorous learning for all students.

Performance Objective 2: Throughout the 2019 - 2020 school year, Elkins Elementary will increase the level of Parent/Family engagement and participation and encourage partnerships between home and school.

Goal 3: SAFE AND NURTURING ENVIRONMENT: We will promote safe, nurturing relationships and environment which positively impact the emotional and physical health of the learning community (ASPIRE 2, 3, 5).

Performance Objective 1: 100% of staff will receive training in Standard Response Protocol on how to react during emergency events that might take place.

Performance Objective 2: 100% of staff and students at Elkins will understand and implement positive character building traits on a daily basis resulting in a decrease in bullying incidents and discipline referrals.

Performance Objective 3: Elkins Elementary will work to achieve an attendance rate of 97% for the 2019 - 2020 school year.
