Performance Objective 1: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, students in all student groups will meet or exceed 85% in the approaches standard category and 80% in the meets standard category, as measured by the 2020 Reading STAAR assessment, 85% of K-2 students will be on or above grade level as measured by the Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System.

Targeted or ESF High Priority

Performance Objective 2: BY the end of the 2019-2020 school year, students in all student groups will meet or exceed 85% in the approaches and meets standard category, as measured by the 2020 Math STAAR assessment, 85% of K-2 students will be on or above grade level as measured by progress monitoring tools.

Performance Objective 3: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, students in all student groups will meet or exceed 85% in the approaches standard category and 80% in the meets standard category , as measured by the 2020 Writing STAAR assessment, 70% of K-3, 5 students will be on or above grade level as measured by Lucy Calkins writing assessments.

Performance Objective 4: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, students in all student groups will meet or exceed 85% in the approaches standard category and 80% in the meets standard category as measured by the 2019 Science STAAR assessment.

Performance Objective 5: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 85% of ESL students will meet yearly progress on the 2019-2020 TELPAS Composite Rating.

Performance Objective 6: By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, 85% of special education students will meet or exceed the approaches standard category and 80% in the meets standard category, as measured by the 2020 STAAR reading, writing, math, and science assessment.
