

## FAQ

### What if I already paid \$40?

The \$40 paid in the fall semester was ONLY the deposit to secure a test order. The test exam cost is:

- \$86 per regular exam
- (\$53 w/ qualifying fee reduction)
- \$134 per AP Capstone exam (\$101 w/ qualifying fee reduction)

### What if I don't pay my remaining balance?

Your exam will be cancelled and no refund will be issued.

### What if I want to take an exam and didn't make a deposit in the Fall?

You can still take the exam!

You must pay the original test fee + a \$40 late fee PER exam you wish to add.

- \$126 per regular exam
- (\$93 w/ qualifying fee reduction)
- \$174 per AP Capstone exam (\$141 w/ qualifying fee reduction)

### What if I no longer want to take the AP exam, and I paid the \$40 deposit.

You may cancel the exam but no refunds can be given for deposits because of the College Board exam cancellation fees.
