Reconnect 2020 Campus Safety Plan

Entry/Exit/Office

The district will provide:

- Signage for mask requirements
- Hand sanitizer stations at all main entrances of building
- Portable stand-alone dispensers in high-traffic areas
- Sneeze shields will be installed in reception areas

Boswell will provide:

- Signage for mask requirements upon entry
- Designated entry/exit doors
- Students will be permitted in the building at 8:40AM and report to 1st period class
- Morning entry will be west and east parking, front of school, and bus drop-off
- Students will have a staggered release at the end of the school day
- Visitors will be allowed in the building for academic purposes only
- All ARD/504 meetings will be virtual via TEAMS

Passing Periods

The district will provide:

• Stand-alone, portable hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed throughout the building and hallways

Boswell will provide:

- Reminder message at the end of each period to be masked, walk and talk, and no eating and drinking
- Water bottle filling stations will be added throughout the building
- While transitioning to common areas and to classrooms, all adults and students will wear face coverings.

<u>Breakfast</u>

• Grab and Go



• Students will move to classrooms after they get their food or upon entering the building

<u>Lunch</u>

The district will provide:

• Utilization of My School Bucks is the payment method of choice. If cash is utilized, no change will be given.

Boswell will provide:

- Students will be required to wear a mask at all times unless actively eating or drinking at their table
- Four locations for lunch seating
- Tables placed in courtyard for all lunches
- Reduced seating at tables
- Removal of couches in Bistro
- One person per bench, two people total at café booths
- No delivered lunches

<u>Classroom</u>

The district will provide:

- Tote bags provided for cleaning in between classes
- Shields for every other desk in classroom

Boswell will provide:

- Students will wear face masks correctly covering nose and chin in all classes
- Canvas will be utilized for all assignments and submission to limit hand-to-hand exchange of paper
- Students will sit in their assigned seat each day
- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle and hand sanitizer
- Students in Choir/Band/Fine Arts will wear face coverings. Students will wear masks/face coverings while they are actively playing/singing.
- Students in EMS-ISD athletics/PE will wear face masks unless actively exercising. This includes locker rooms, and when they are not able to 6 feet social distance. Students will always keep their masks with them. They remove them while actively exercising, but they must put them back on once their activity is over, or while transitioning through stations.
