
News from our PTA

Fourth Grade


We would like to start by saying "thank you" to all our wonderful fourth grade parents. Your support has been greatly appreciated. The following is a list of topics that will be covered this month: Math: Students will continue to work on fluency with all operations. We will work with standard algorithms for addition, multiplication, and division. We will work on fractions and decimals as needed. **Science**: Students will learn that producers make their own food. We will discuss that consumers are dependent on other organisms for their food. Students will demonstrate that the flow of energy through food webs begins with the Sun. We will discuss that changes in an ecosystem can affect food webs. Reading: Students will research various topics that they read about in books. Students will develop drafts into a focused, structured, and coherent piece of writing.

Social St: Students will explain the impact of Texas Culture and Texas Arts.

Fifth Grade

Math and science - We are reviewing for STAAR. The focus is on the high stakes TEKs that comprise the majority of the STAAR in both subject areas. After STAAR we will focus on recapturing TEKs that will set the foundation for success in 6th grade.

ELAR & Social Studies - Over the next three weeks, students will be researching and presenting information on one of the 50 states. Students will be guided through the research process during class. We are looking forward to our field trip on May 12. It has been a wonderful year and we wish our 5th graders all the best as the move on to 6th grade!
