Requests for information must be made in writing to invoke the Public Information Act. Requests must be submitted to the district using one of three official avenues: via email to info@ems-isd.net, by mail addressed to the EMS ISD Communications Office, or delivered in person to the Communications Office at the district administration building. Requests not submitted through these defined avenues are not considered an official request to the district and, in accordance with public information law, the district is not obligated to respond.
PORTFOLIOS	 AP Art students will create their art portfolio (investigation, experimentation, communication, and selected works) according to the regulations and expectations of College Board. AP Art teachers and coaches will provide guidance throughout the creation process, ensuring the rules of the College Board are clearly followed. AP Portfolios can be entered into the district's art showcase to be judged for placement and scholarship. After the judging is completed by third party, impartial experts, the AP Art portfolios will be considered by the Director and Assistant Director of Fine Arts to determine if any pieces should be omitted from the floor display before opening the doors for our community. Possible exclusion from the public show involves displays that include activities, items, or references to prohibited behaviors according to the EMS ISD Student Code of Conduct and/or deemed inappropriate for audiences of all ages. AP Art teachers and coaches will help prepare students and parents for the public showcase. EMS ISD administration reserves the right to omit artwork from any EMS ISD att showcase, EMS ISD public or digital display, or EMS ISD associated social media outlet.
