In order to be awarded a private lesson scholarship, we agree to the following expectations:

- 1. The student will maintain academic eligibility (passing grades) each 6 weeks.
- 2. The student will participate in solo contest- all grades and all-region for 7th or 8th grade.
- 3. The student will be responsible for remembering to attend each lesson whether scheduled during school or after school. Scholarship money will NOT pay for missed lessons. Absences due to illness will be rescheduled if possible.
- 4. The student will give above average effort, have good to excellent behavior and maintain a 90 or above average in choir.
- 5. Families will make timely payments to their private lesson teacher each month.
- 6. Families will participate in all fundraisers beyond choir fees to help offset the cost of lessons. The approximate cost to the choir for the year for a ½ scholarship is \$300, so your help is needed to make this possible for your student.

Students who fail to meet these expectations may be dismissed from the scholarship program at the director's discretion. Students may continue lessons at the full rate but not during their choir class period.
