

## District Peace Officer Beneficiary Designation Form for Duty Weapon and Badge

---

**Note:** Texas Government Code 615.102 allows any individual listed in Government Code 615.003(1) who is employed by the District, including a District-employed peace officer, to designate a beneficiary to receive, at no cost, upon the employee's death the deceased employee's duty weapon, if any, and badge. If there is no designated beneficiary on file with the District, the District will provide the items to the deceased's estate. The District is not liable for damages caused by the use or misuse of a duty weapon provided to a designated beneficiary or estate.

Government Code 615.103 requires a District to provide the peace officer's uniform at no cost if the fallen officer's family requests for the officer to be buried in his or her uniform.
