GRADUATION,

In accordance with law, not later than September 1 of each year, the District will notify by regular mail or email the parents of or person standing in parental relation to each student enrolled in grade 9 or above that a student is not required to complete Algebra II to graduate under the foundation high school program.

GRADUATION
CEREMONY

Watson High School graduates may participate in both the Watson High School graduation ceremony and the ceremony of their original high school. Students admitted directly into Watson High School without attending one of the Eagle Mountain-Saginaw ISD high schools will be eligible only for the Watson High School ceremony. For the Watson High School ceremony, all students will wear black robes. For the other high school ceremonies, they will wear the corresponding high school gown.

POSTHUMOUS
DIPLOMAS

A parent may request a diploma from EMS ISD if their child was enrolled at the time of their death. This posthumously-awarded diploma will be granted in the year that the graduation class of which the student would have graduated with at the time of their passing is awarded and will be sent directly to the parents. For example, if a student died during his/her freshman year, the diploma would not be awarded until that student's class sits for graduation.

This is effective for students who would have graduated at the end of the 2019-2020 school year.
